HERD HEALTH & PROCESSING

- Customized vaccination, parasite-control, and biosecurity programs
- Written treatment protocols, withdrawal guidance, and herd-record review
- Castration, dehorning, implants, vaccination, and deworming
- Employee training, facility/workflow review, and processing-day support

REPRODUCTIVE MANAGEMENT

- Ultrasound pregnancy diagnosis, fetal aging, and fetal sex determination
- Bull breeding soundness examinations and breeding-readiness evaluation
- Artificial insemination and embryo-transfer consultation/services
- Infertility, poor pregnancy-rate, and breeding-season investigation

REPLACEMENT HEIFERS
